Kassem Fawaz is an Assistant Professor in the Electrical & Computer Engineering department at the University of Wisconsin - Madison. He earned his Ph.D. in Computer Science and Engineering from the University of Michigan. He was awarded the Caspar Bowden Award for Outstanding Research in Privacy Enhancing Technologies in 2019. He also received the National Science Foundation CAREER award in 2020.
